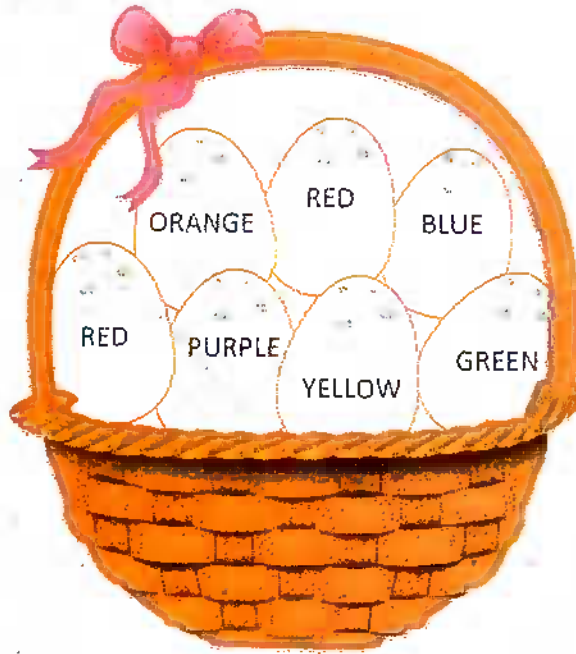

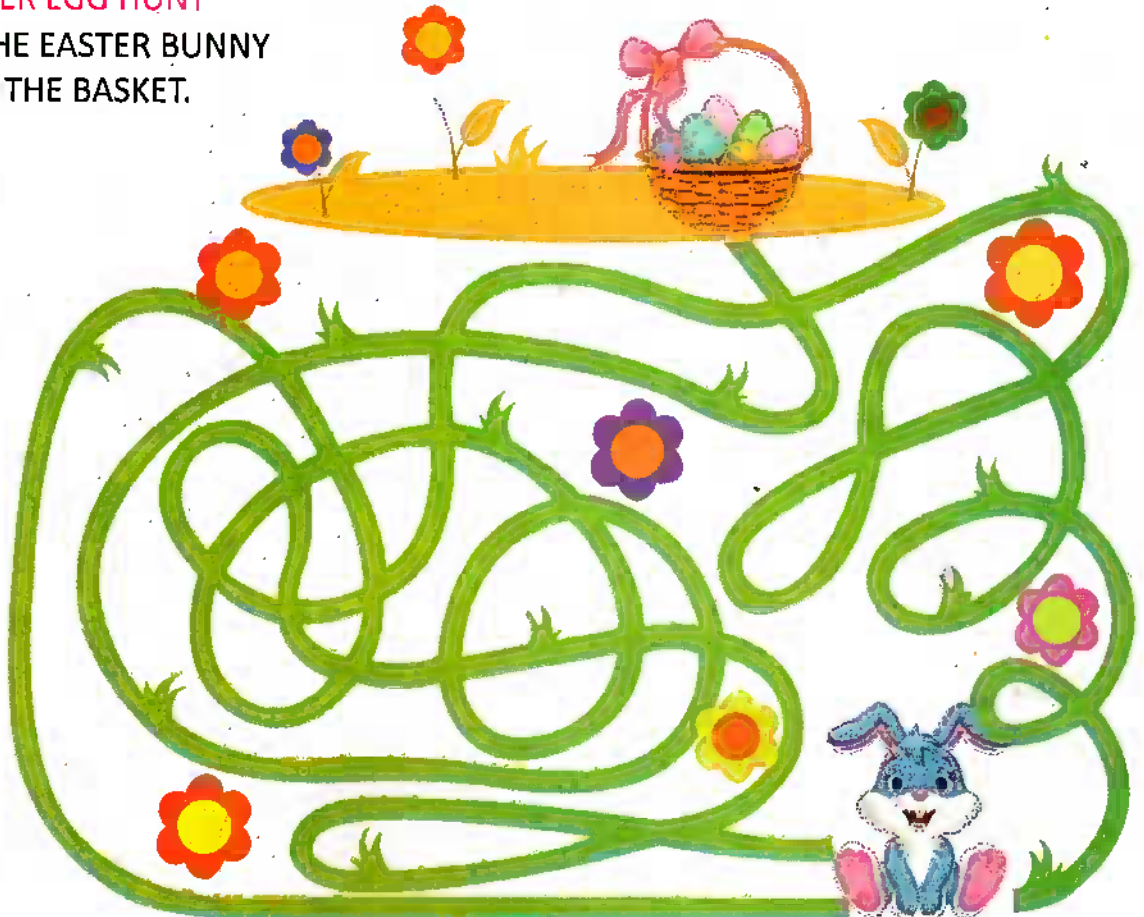

Teacher's note: Let's play the game!

Easter Egg Faces. Review face vocabulary (eyes, ears, nose, mouth, hair, eyebrows, cheeks, chin etc.). Use real egg shells (before class get some eggs, puncture a hole at both ends and blow out the insides of the egg, then wash out). Do as a listening activity – Teacher says “draw a nose” and children draw a nose, and so on.

Bunny Hopping Exercises. Have learners hop to your instructions (like an Easter Bunny): Hop slowly, hop quickly, big hops, small hops, turn around hops, hop on left / right foot, hop forward / backwards / sideways, close your eyes and hop, flap your arms and hop etc.
